We aim to fulfill the mission of Littleton SEPAC by being a supportive, informative and encouraging forum for parents, guardians and their children; by providing information, resources; opportunities to raise questions and to voice concerns, and by being a bridge providing direct input to administrators and the School Committee.

### When do we meet?

We have at least four meetings every year. In addition we host at least one annual Special Education basic rights workshop for parents.
